#### FEEDING PROGRAM IN THE PHILIPPINES

MSM are delighted to report the growth and development of the feeding program in ILLIGAN City. The feeding program was set up to support some of the most needy children in the city, including those who live and work on the dump site. To meet the need more effectively the program has been relocated to a Day Care Center just beside the dump site and numbers attending have increased significantly to between 150 to 200 each week. MSM arranged for a team of volunteers including two nurses to visit the area and carry out a de-worming program for over 250 children.

Pastor Stephen Villaster and the 3J2 Bible Centre Church who set up the program would like to extend the program to other depressed areas in the city and they also have an exciting vision to further serve the community. Their heart is to establish a centre where they can hold church, school, the feeding program and vocational training to help poorer people increase their earning potential. MSM are keen to support their vision and the challenge is to help raise the finances needed to purchase land or property to enable all of this to happen.

#### **VALUES AND OBJECTIVES**

Mustard Seed Ministries is a registered charity established in 1993, whose inspiration and values derive from a faith in the Lord Jesus Christ and the truths contained in Scripture. Committed to working in partnership with the broader church worldwide to bring change to the lives of individuals and communities through prayer and mission rooted in practical love. Currently we are working in India, Bangladesh and the Philippines, supporting churches, orphanages, care homes and missionaries. 


#### BANGALORE:
