LITTLE ANGELS CARE HOME, GOA, INDIA.

Through many experiences MSM has developed a particular heart for children with special needs and so we are delighted to have been integral to the development of Little Angels home which opened in April 2009. Initially the home was able to care for eight children and young people aged between 7 and 25 years. There are many more needy children on the waiting list and they will be admitted as soon as funds and staffing allow.

The aim of the home is to offer children with special needs a loving and encouraging environment with appropriate education and training to enable them to express their talents and become, where possible, independent and self supporting adults. Whilst the Christian ethos is at the heart of the project the home is open to children and young people from all backgrounds irrespective of cast , creed or religion. As this worthwhile project develops it aims to provide much needed respite care for children with special needs, reaching out to support the families as well as the children.


VALUES AND OBJECTIVES


### VILLAGE MINISTRY:


