DEVELOPMENTS IN THE PHILIPPINES

A great development in the last year has been the opportunity for MSM to work alongside people and projects in three of the main islands of the Philippines. In Iligan City MSM are supporting a Pastor and his Church to run a Feeding Program to support some of the most needy children, including those who live and work on the nearby dump site (pictured above). The project is expanding and the numbers attending have reached 90 - 100. When fire and floods hit the city they were able to reach out to help and support these children and their families with food and resources.

MSM's vision is to help individuals and project to become self sustaining and in line with this we have initiated a small program of business start up loans through churches to give poorer people the opportunity to improve their standard of living. MSM Trustees and volunteers have visited the Philippines to encourage these Churches and projects and have funded and participated in Pastors Conferences, Church services and youth events.

VALUES AND OBJECTIVES

Mustard Seed Ministries is a registered charity established in 1993, whose inspiration and values derive from a faith in the Lord Jesus Christ and the truths contained in Scripture. Committed to working in partnership with the broader church worldwide to bring change to the lives of individuals and communities through prayer and mission rooted in practical love. Currently we are largely working in India supporting street children, orphanages and villagers, our aim is not to own or badge these projects, but to support local people at the cutting edge who know, care and understand the problems they face. Alongside financial support MSM offer practical and spiritual help and seeks to develop relationships between projects for mutual support, encouragement and the sharing of resources.

MADRAS:

Joseph and Rosie provide a secure and loving home for 48 children. With support from MSM the older children receive vocational education, ranging from engineering to teacher training giving them the best start in life. A.F.R.A also run a day care centre for local children and are always seeking to expand their work to help poor rural communities.




BANGALORE:
