### DEVELOPMENTS IN GOA

A great development is that Pedro and Genilda Lima are now working under the umbrella of Mustard Seed Ministries. Trained missionaries, they have been living and working in India for the past 7 years. Their extensive experience in supporting children and their passion to make a difference has led to a request from the Institute of Public Assistance in Goa to develop and oversee three care homes: a home for boys, (pictured above), a girls home and also a home for elderly men. In addition they are supporting the reintegration of children who have left care to return to their native villages and have recently opened "The Little Ones" creche to provide much needed opportunities for local children and support for their families.

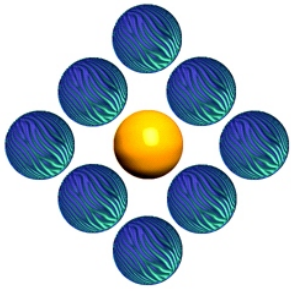
### VALUES AND OBJECTIVES

### BANGALORE:

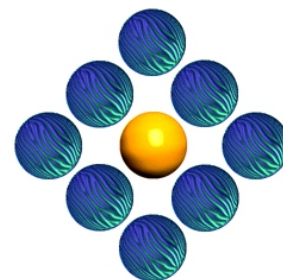

### **VILLAGE MINISTRY:**

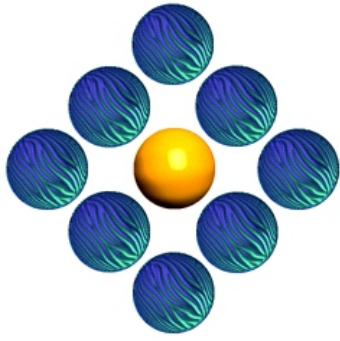
