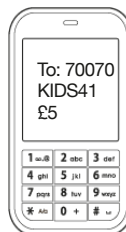

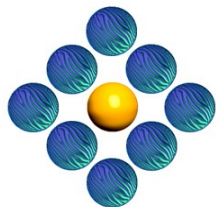
### VALUES AND OBJECTIVES

### INDIA:

MSM support **Little Angels** a home for special needs which provides love and support to 18 young people in Goa. More recently **House of Hope** a social care project for boys and girls in Chandigarh. Near Chennai, **AFRA** has a heart for the poor and offer social care assist with education and support surrounding leprosy colonies.



### BANGLADESH:

MSM have developed a relationship with **BRYFC** who are committed to serving the poorest of the poor, especially the youth, children, mothers, widows and aged people, for their education health, economic and spiritual development. We are focussing on raising support for the needs of teachers and pupils in some primary schools in poorer rural communities.



### COMMUNITY SUPPORT:

MSM have a great affinity with the elderly and have developed special relationships with a number of homes. We also support young adults & children in the community who were previously in care. MSM have links with very poor families and rural villages, and are keen to help in any way that we can.

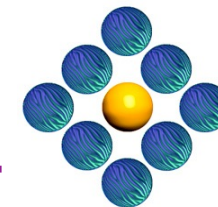


### PASTORS/CHURCHES:
